

## **SPECIES SEEN ON RVAS KLAMATH BASIN FIELD TRIP FEBRUARY 4, 2012**

Greater White-fronted Goose – two large flocks seen flying overhead

Snow Goose – huge flock (approx. 5,000 birds) at Tule Lake

Canada Goose

Tundra Swan – several thousand seen at several locations

American Wigeon

Eurasian Wigeon – one male seen at Tule Lake

Mallard

Canvasback – several seen at Tule Lake

Lesser Scaup – few individuals seen at Tule Lake

Bufflehead

Common Merganser – one bird seen at Tule Lake

California Quail – seen at Visitor Center feeder

Great Blue Heron – one seen flying over Township Road late afternoon

Ring-billed Gull – two seen briefly flying over Lower Klamath Tour Route

Golden Eagle – one seen flying over Hill Rd., one at metal barn site on Lower Klamath Lake Road

Rough-legged Hawk – one bird well seen on Lower Klamath Tour Route, others were in fields  
along Township Road late afternoon

Ferruginous Hawk – two seen well at metal barn site on Lower Klamath Lake Road

American Kestrel

Prairie Falcon – one seen very well along Hill Road, total of four seen

American Coot

Belted Kingfisher – one along path to Discovery marsh (adjacent to lunch area)

Northern Flicker

Western Scrub-jay – seen along Keno-Worden Road while driving home

Black-billed Magpie

Common Raven – few seen in fields along Township Road

Horned Lark – small flock seen briefly flying near Lower Klamath Tour Route

American Robin

European Starling

Song Sparrow – one bird heard briefly during stop on Lower Klamath Tour Route

Dark-eyed Junco – seen at Visitor Center feeder

Brewer's Blackbird – large flock near Hwy 97/Stateline Rd. intersection

Red-winged Blackbird

Tricolored Blackbird – part of big flock seen along Hill Road

Yellow-headed Blackbird – part of big flock seen along Hill Road

Purple Finch – seen at Visitor Center feeder

House Finch

Lesser Goldfinch – seen at Visitor Center feeder

House Sparrow – seen at Visitor Center feeder
